**1. Introduction**

A heavy duty beaded hand-cleansing gel, designed to remove heavy soiling. The kerosene based gel formulation has been specifically designed to melt on the hand when subjected to body heat allowing for better penetration and removal of ground-in dirt. The added poly-beads enhance the cleaning action without scouring skin.

BHGR red coloured viscous gel, with pleasant fresh fragrance.

BHGO orange coloured viscous gel, with citrus fragrance.

- Suitable for use in any area where heavy soiling of the hands occurs: garages, workshops, printing industry, building industry, DIY, etc.

**6. Application Details**

Apply to dry hands and work well into skin for 20 seconds to loosen dirt. Remove by washing hands in clean warm water. Dry hands thoroughly after use and apply moisturising cream to keep skin in good condition.

N.B. Prior to commencing any work always use barrier cream to aid the removal of ground-in soil. Always reapply after washing hands.
